

In Delhi, under Delhi State Health Mission (DSHM), Hon'ble Chief Minister of Delhi, Smt. Shiela Dikshit, launched a state level campaign on "Homoeopathy for Healthy Mother and Happy child" on 24/09/2009. This was followed by 2 days of workshop, attended by nearly 250 participants, which included Allopathic physicians, Gynecologists, Obstetricians, Pediatricians, RCH doctors, Ayurvedic/ Unani physicians, and Homoeopathic physicians from Government and private sector.

In the next phase, as per the directions of Deptt of AYUSH, Min of H&FW, GOI, we shall commence in the North West District the campaign as per the following schedule:

1. One day District Orientation Training programme on 24/11/2009 for around 100 Medical Practitioners.
2. Three days capacity building training programme from 25/11/2009 to 27/11/2009 for around 20 Homoeopathic Practitioners.
3. Simultaneously IEC activities i.e. Posters, Handouts, training of ASHA etc.

Hon'ble Health Minister of Delhi, Prof. Kiran Walia, has consented to inaugurate the North West District Orientation programme on 24th November, 2009 at 12.00 NOON in the auditorium of Dr Baba Saheb Ambedkar hospital, sector 6, Rohini. She shall also be inaugurating the 82nd Delhi Govt Homoeopathic Dispensary at Rohini Sector – 18 simultaneously.

The main objective of the Orientation programme is to sensitize the participants (consisting mainly of Allopathic Medical specialists from RCH, Obs/ Gynae and Paeds field and other AYUSH doctors) about the benefits of Homoeopathy in the provision of Mother & Child health. The specifics include ensuring cross referrals and co-ordination at grass root level, which shall go a long way in reducing 'Mother & Child' morbidity and mortality in Delhi.

This one day distt orientation programme shall be followed by three days training programme for capacity building of around 20 homoeopathic physicians in the auditorium of Dr Baba Saheb Ambedkar hospital, sector 6, Rohini. Medical specialists from the filed of Obs/ Gynae, Paeds and Homoeopathy from GNCTD hospitals shall be resource persons in this training programme as per the attached schedule.
